



Bachelor of Arts, Architectural Studies

The John H. Daniels Faculty of Architecture, Landscape, and Design is now accepting applications for admission to the Bachelor of Arts in Architectural Studies program in September 2012. Applications must be submitted to the Ontario Universities Application Centre (OUAC).

The Bachelor of Arts (BA) Degree in Architectural Studies at the Daniels Faculty grounds its graduates in the fundamentals of Architecture, Landscape Architecture, and Urban Design. Whether you wish to eventually enter the professions of Architecture or Landscape Architecture (both of which require an additional professional master's degree), or plan to pursue a career or graduate studies in another field, the Bachelor of Arts in Architectural Studies will provide unparalleled and internationally recognized academic preparation. Our graduates go on to pursue careers in a wide range of design and environmentally related fields, from architecture, city planning, real estate, geography, or sustainable building sciences, to film, video, graphic, and other media-based arts.

This program provides a broad, design-based lens through which to study the arts and humanities, and a deep foundation in all the disciplines related to architecture and urbanism.

Two majors in architectural studies are offered:

- The **Architectural Design** concentration exposes students to architectural design within a broad liberal arts education.

- The **History, Theory and Criticism** concentration exposes students to a broad interdisciplinary education in architectural studies.
- Students may major in both Architectural Design, and History, Theory and Criticism.

A BA in Architectural Studies may also be combined with a major in another discipline at the University of Toronto, such as urban studies, fine art, or computer science. Graduates who have completed a BA in Architectural Studies as well as those who have completed the equivalent of a BA degree in another area of study may apply to graduate programs in architecture, landscape architecture, and urban design.

To be considered for admission applicants must obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and present at least six senior high school credits (Grade 12 U or M courses in the Ontario school system) including English 1/4U prior to the start of the program.
