Occasional attendance at meetings and tribunals is required.

QUALIFICATIONS: Positions are available only to students enrolled in the School of Graduate Studies at the University of Toronto. First consideration will be given to graduate students with experience in conducting Faculty final examinations. General qualifications include: ability to carry out procedures under pressure using tact and judgement, ability to effectively direct large groups, and ability to communicate clearly and effectively.

RATE OF PAY: \$31.00 per hour, as specified in the Collective Agreement between The Governing Council of the University of Toronto and The Canadian Union of Public Employees, Local 3902. Chief Presiding Officers will be paid for one hour in addition to the duration of each assigned examination (either two or three hours) in order to fulfil pre- and post-examination responsibilities. Four per cent vacation pay will also be paid.
