

How to Pre-pay Tuition Fees at Daniels Faculty for Study Permit Purposes

Some international students can get their study permits faster by using the Student Direct Stream.

You can apply if you are a legal resident in:

- China
- India
- the Philippines, or
- Vietnam

If you live in another country (even if you are a citizen of one of the countries above), you have to apply through the [regular study permit application process](#).

Documents you need for your application

You must include these documents with your application:

- a copy of your acceptance letter from a [designated learning institution](#)
- a copy of your [upfront medical exam](#) confirmation document
- proof that you have a Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC) of \$10,000
- **proof that you've paid the tuition fees for your first year of study**, and
- proof that you graduated from a Canadian curriculum high school **or** a language test form showing a
 - score of at least 6 for English ([International English Language Testing System](#)), or
 - Niveaux de compétence linguistique canadiens score of at least 7 for French ([Test d'évaluation de français](#))

Following are the steps you need to follow to pre-pay your tuition fees for your first year of study at Daniels.

Tuition Fees Amount to Pay

The tuition fees that you will need to pay for the 2019-20 academic year will be reflected on your ACORN tuition fees invoice in mid-July. In the meantime, view below the estimated amount of international tuition fees for the Daniels program that you have been admitted to (all amounts in Canadian dollars):

Pre-pay the amount listed for your program in the Total Fees column above.

IMPORTANT NOTE: As these are estimated amounts, your actual tuition fees may be higher or lower than these estimated amounts.

How to Pay

If pre-paying from outside Canada:

- **WU Global Pay for Students Service.** The University of Toronto has authorized WU Global Pay for Students to process incoming international student tuition and residence fee payments for the University of Toronto. This service is safer and more secure than international wire transfer. The University will not accept international wire transfer payments.

- **Bank draft with micro-encoding** (a series of numbers along the bottom of the bank draft) in Canadian dollars drawn on a Canadian bank branch.
 - Send to the Student Accounts Office with a copy of the letter of offer/admission that provides the student number and program.
 - If not accompanied by the letter of offer/admission, payment will be deposited in the 'unidentified payments' account. This means it will take longer to generate a proof of payment letter.

- **Note:** online credit card payment option is not available as the service limits payment amount to the student account balance (money-laundering prevention measure).

If pre-paying from inside Canada:

- If prepaying for first year tuition fees from Canadian bank account, make an online bank payment. Instructions can be viewed at <http://www.fees.utoronto.ca/Assets/Student+Accounts+Digital+Assets/20195+Summer/payment.pdf>.

Request Proof of Payment

Once payment has been made, send an email message to the Daniels Office of the Registrar and Student Services at awards@daniels.utoronto.ca asking for proof of payment that you can attach to your study permit application. Email must include:

- Your complete name
- Your UT student number
 - Included in your letter of offer/admission
 - Undergraduate/bachelor students – your UT student number is your JOINId number
 - Graduate/masters students – your UT student number is your UT applicant number
- Copy of the payment transaction made through the payment options listed above.

The Office of the Registrar will generate a proof of payment letter once your payment is reflected on your ACORN account. It may take between 3 and 7 business days from the date the payment was made before the payment is reflected on your ACORN account.

Your proof of payment letter will be emailed as a PDF document.
